

## High School Straight Truck CDL Cohort

January – May 2020

This exciting opportunity will prepare high school students to obtain a Class B commercial driver's license that enables them to operate such vehicles as dump trucks, delivery trucks, flatbed and tanker vehicles. This course focuses on pre-trip vehicle inspections, defensive driving habits, gear shifting, backing skills, industry regulations and safe maneuvering skills. Students will begin instruction at the FVTC regional campus in Waupaca, and complete their training at the state-of-the-art transportation center on the Appleton Campus.



### Course dates:

- Waupaca sessions – January 21<sup>st</sup> to March 12th
- Appleton sessions – March 24th to May 14th
- All sessions run 5:00 – 9:00 pm

### Student Requirements:

- Age 18 by March 1, 2020 and payment of fees related to a DOT physical (approx. \$87), drug screening (approx. \$68) and a learner's permit (approx. \$30).
- Students must also provide own transportation to both Waupaca and Appleton campus class sessions.

FVTC will cover the tuition cost and CDL tests upon completion of this course (approx. \$1,200). This opportunity is funded through a Wisconsin Fast Forward grant.
