1. **PREMIER COMMUNITY BANK SCHOLARSHIP**

- Minimum of 3.0 GPA
- Financial need
- Business related major
- Attend four year college
- Amount : 1 @ \$500
- Please answer the following in less than 250 words on a separate, labeled sheet. Use 1 inch margins, Calibri font and no less than 11 sized font: ***Outline your future goals.***

2. **BETHKE**

- Minimum of 3.0 GPA
- Male recipients must not have any facial hair and keep hair cut short
- Interview by local community members required
- Amount varies, divided among many recipients
- **Graduation picture required**

3. **ALBERT AND ELMER HAHN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

- First priority to students pursuing technical-school education in farming, plumbing, electrical, or carpentry.
- Amount: 2 @ \$500 (if no trade students apply, 1 scholarship will be awarded to a general student)

4. **CORA JONES**

- Considerations:
 - Community Service
 - Clean criminal record
 - Accepted into 2 year or 4 year college majoring in Criminal Justice, Emergency Services, EMT/Paramedic, or other medical related (helping profession) career.
- Amount: 1 @\$1,000
- Please answer the following in 100-200 words on a separate, labeled sheet. Use 1 inch margins, Calibri font and no less than 11 sized font:

5. **DAVID AND MEGAN SMITH SCHOLARSHIP**

- Minimum GPA 3.0
- Amount: \$7,500
- Open to all majors (preference given to students majoring in business related field)

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6. **FARMERS STATE BANK SCHOLARSHIP**
 - Must have a 3.0 GPA
 - Open to any major, not just business
 - Amount : 1 @ \$750

7. **FREMONT AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE ---PENDING---**
 - Must have a 3.0 GPA
 - Business related major – economics, marketing or finance
 - Amount : 1 at \$500

8. **NEUSCHAFER SCHOLARSHIP**
 - Must have participated in the science fair at W-F or other district
 - Must submit list of age or grade entered and topic of entry
 - Must have taken elective science classes at W-F or previous districts
 - Must submit list of all elective science classes taken
 - Amount : 1 @ \$500

9. **STAMM - HIGH SCHOOL**
 - Minimum GPA of 3.5 (weighted)
 - Available to any graduating senior **living within the Weyauwega - Fremont School District**
 - Considerations: Academics, Extra-Curricular Activity, Need , Moral Character, Leadership
 - Amount: Varies, but given to many applicants (typically \$250-\$4,000)

10. **WEYAUWEGA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE**
 - Enter business related career
 - Amount : 1 @ \$250

11. **W-F ALUMNI AND FRIENDS ASSOCIATION**
 - Minimum GPA of 2.8
 - Service to school and community and demonstrates leadership
 - Financial need
 - Amount: 1@ \$1,000

12. **W-F EDUCATION ASSOCIATION**
 - Major in Education
 - Minimum GPA of 3.5
 - Outstanding leadership
 - Amount: 1 @ \$250

13. **W-F LIONS CLUB-AGRICULTURAL**
 - Must enter an agricultural field
 - Amount: 1 @ \$300
 - Please answer the following in 100-200 words on a separate, labeled sheet. Use 1 inch margins, Calibri font and no less than 11 sized font: ***Explain your agriculture background, career and education goals and school and community involvement.***

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14. **W-F LIONS-BUSINESS**

- Enter and study a business related field
- Amount: 1 @ \$300
- Please answer the following in 100-200 words on a separate, labeled sheet. Use 1 inch margins, Calibri font and no less than 11 sized font: ***Explain your career, education and school/community involvement.***

- Rank in the top ten of class in GPA
- Amount: 1 @ \$300

16. **THEDACARE MEDICAL CENTER - NEW LONDON MEDICAL STAFF SCHOLARSHIP**

- Amount: 1 @ \$1,500 to a student at Weyauwega-Fremont High School
- Accepted into a 2 or 4 year college, technical college, or vocational program
- Entering into a healthcare related program
- GPA 2.75 minimum (and continue this GPA in college)
- Must answer questions in the scholarship packet labeled ThedaCare (In Career Center)

17. **HIDES FOR HEROES SCHOLARSHIP (donated by Miron Construction) ---PENDING---**

- Amount: 1 @ \$1,500
- Must have participated in the Hides for Heroes Program
- Student that best exemplifies the spirit of volunteerism through effort and input into the Hides for Heroes Project (**please attach a short essay about what you have done for the Hides for heroes project, how many years have you been involved, etc.**)
- Scholarship must be used for postsecondary education
- This scholarship may not only be for a student at Weyauwega-Fremont

18. **STEVEN RACHWAL FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP**

- Preference to a senior going into a law enforcement, fire science career
- Any senior may apply
- Amount: Varies

19. **PATRICIA & ODIN AEGERTER BERG SCHOLARSHIP**

- Majoring in either a healthcare field or education field
- Amount: \$1,500

20. **HARRIETT DEAN SCHOLARSHIP**

- Applicant must be pursuing a career in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math
- Applicant must be a four year college bound student
- Scholarship will be awarded after students first semester grades are submitted
- Amount: 2 @ \$1,000
- Please answer the following in 100-200 words on a separate, labeled sheet. Use 1 inch margins, Calibri font and no less than 11 sized font: ***Why do you enjoy the STEM field, what are your college plans (undergraduate and beyond), what are your career goals?***
