### 1. PREMIER COMMUNITY BANK SCHOLARSHIP

- Ranked in the upper 50% of class
- Attend four year college or technical college
- Amount : 1 @ \$500.00
- Please answer the following in maximum of 250 words on a separate, labeled sheet. Use 1 inch margins, Calibri font and no less than 11 sized font:  
***Explain your volunteer/community service activities that you participated in throughout your high school career and describe your future goals.***

### 2. BETHKE

- Minimum of 3.0 GPA
- Male recipients must not have any facial hair and keep hair cut short
- Top two ranked students do not qualify
- Interview by local community members required
- Amount varies, divided among many recipients
- **Graduation picture required**

### 3. CASEY LAKE COMMUNITY FUND SCHOLARSHIP

- Senior from Weyauwega-Fremont High School or Waupaca High School
- Must live in the Town of Waupaca
- First consideration will go to a student attending FVTC
- Amount 1 @ \$500.00

### 4. CORA JONES (this is a new scholarship, replacing the former Cora Jones scholarship)

- Considerations:
  - Community Service
  - Clean criminal record
  - Accepted into 2 year or 4 year college majoring in Criminal Justice, Emergency Services, EMT/Paramedic, or other medical related (helping profession) career.
- Amount: 1 @\$1,000
- Please answer the following in 100- 200 words on a separate, labeled sheet. Use 1 inch margins, Calibri font and no less than 11 sized font:  
***What makes you qualified (or a good candidate) to receive this scholarship?***

### 5. FARMERS STATE BANK SCHOLARSHIP

- Must have a 3.0 GPA
- Business related major – economics, marketing, finance, accounting, etc.
- Amount : 1 @ \$500.00

- Please answer the following in 100- 200 words on a separate, labeled sheet. Use 1 inch margins, Calibri font and no less than 11 sized font:  
***Explain your agriculture background, career and education goals and school and community involvement.***

### 17. W-F LIONS-BUSINESS

- Enter and study a business related field
- Amount: 1 @ \$300.00
- Please answer the following in 100- 200 words on a separate, labeled sheet. Use 1 inch margins, Calibri font and no less than 11 sized font:  
***Explain your career, education and school/community involvement.***

### 18. W-F LIONS-SCHOLARS

- Rank in the top ten of class
- Amount: 1 @ \$300.00
- Please answer the following in 100- 200 words on a separate, labeled sheet. Use 1 inch margins, Calibri font and no less than 11 sized font:  
***Describe your high school accomplishments and career/education plans.***

### 19. THEDACARE FOUNDATION-NEW LONDON MEDICAL STAFF SCHOLARSHIP

1. **Graduation picture(s)** – *label* your picture with your name and graduation year. Also place your picture in a *labeled envelope*. Make sure you have a picture for each scholarship that is asking for one. The school will not provide an envelope for you.
2. Page 1 of Application
3. Page 2 of Application
4. Page 3 of Application
5. Page 4 of Application
6. The general essay - Label as “General Essay A or B” with your name
7. The checklist of scholarships (make sure to **double check** that you have marked all the scholarships that you are eligible for! Every year, we see students forgetting to check scholarships that they would have qualified for...**WE CANNOT MARK ANY FOR YOU!!**)
8. Essays for specific scholarships (if applicable) – Make sure the appropriate scholarship name and your name is on your essay!!!!
